Driving Directions to Creswell RC Flyers Flying site (Walker Airport)

From North of Creswell (Eugene)

Take Interstate 5 South

Take 182 Creswell exit

Turn right at freeway off ramp on to Cloverdale Rd/E Oregon Ave

Continue to follow E Oregon Ave for 200 yds to RR tracks

Turn left immediately beyond RR tracks on to Highway 99 (small road)

Continue on Highway 99 south (3.5 mi)

You will see Walker Airport on your right (look for small hangars and wind sock)

Continue to the south end of the field

Turn Right into the gated driveway

Gate will be unlocked if Club members are there.

From South of Creswell (Cottage Grove)

Go on I-5 North

Take Saginaw exit and turn left from off ramp

Cross freeway overpass heading west toward RR tracks

Take immediately right beyond RR tracks on to Highway 99

Go for about 3-4 miles on Highway 99 north

Look for the Sportsman Club sign (gun club) on your left....

Go past the gun club for 250 yards and you'll come to our RC club gate on your left, which is at the south end of Walker Airport

RC Club gate will be unlocked if Club members are there.

GPS Coordinates for Walker Field:

Latitude 43 degrees 52 minutes (rounded off)

Longitude = 123 degrees 02 minutes (rounded off)

Parking

Pilots - Enter at North Gate - DO NOT DRIVE ON RUNWAY, stay close to hangers

Spectators - Enter at South Gate - park to the left of the entrance.
