### Treasury report:

Rod also had a couple of Plane stands made out of treated lumber. He has plans available for anyone who would like to make one for the club or themselves.

### Sponsors:

Brad Mc. presented sign samples and costs from the Springfield School District print shop that could be used for the sponsorship signage. The members present approved to use the Correx Sign material with a cut vinyl material for outdoor use. It is expected to last for 3-5 years exposed to the weather and will cost \$120 for a 3'x5' and \$90 for a 2'x4' sign. These signs will be for the \$1000 and \$500 sponsors displayed on the hanger door.
